



Tuition & Refund Schedule

Total Cost of Mach Hach BaAretz 2022: \$8,150 (includes a \$400 deposit)
The deposit is due with application (\$250 of which is refundable until December 31st)
Second Payment is due by January 1, 2022: \$2000
Third Payment is due by March 1, 2022: \$2500
Final Payment is due by May 1, 2022

An Early-Bird Discount of \$100 will be given to those who apply before November 1, 2021.
A Late Fee of \$100 will be charged to those who apply after February 1, 2022.
A \$1400 credit will be given to those who choose to purchase their own plane ticket.
Pay in full before April 1, 2022 and save \$100.

Travel insurance is available for US citizens. This will protect your tuition payments should you choose to cancel. You will recoup 75-100% of the nonrefundable portion of your tuition depending on your reasons for cancellation and according to the details of the respective plan. Details can be found in the "Forms" section of the website. Cost: Basic Plan-\$254, Deluxe-\$370.50.

Refund Schedule:

January 1 through February 28: \$600 is nonrefundable
March 1 through April 30: \$1250 is nonrefundable
May 1 through May 31: \$3000 is nonrefundable
After June 1: no refunds will be granted
